





The average annual salary in #brnoregion is about EUR 12,000 but it can easily reach twice that for IT jobs. The Czech Republic has among the lowest living costs in the EU. Statistics show the country to be the most content EU nation probably because of these low costs (though money isn't everything, of course).

Do you prefer the countryside or the city with all its comforts? #brnoregion has them both; there is no "or".








